MICHAEL “MIKE” AIKEN JR. IS A SKILLED AND EXPERIENCED LEAD GUARD FROM WASHINGTON, D.C., WHO HAS PRODUCED AT BOTH THE NAIA AND NCAA DIVISION II LEVELS. AIKEN COMBINES SPEED, PERIMETER SHOOTING, BALL-HANDLING, AND OFFENSIVE EFFICIENCY IN A COMPACT POINT-GUARD FRAME. HE HAS SHOWN THE ABILITY TO FUNCTION AS BOTH A PRIMARY SCORER AND FACILITATOR WHILE PLAYING WITHIN MULTIPLE COLLEGIATE SYSTEMS.

AIKEN FIRST ESTABLISHED HIMSELF AT WILEY UNIVERSITY, WHERE HE IMMEDIATELY BECAME ONE OF THE WILDCATS' PRIMARY OFFENSIVE CONTRIBUTORS AS A FRESHMAN. HE LATER TRANSFERRED HOME TO THE UNIVERSITY OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, DEVELOPING INTO AN ALL-EAST COAST CONFERENCE PERFORMER AND ONE OF THE MOST EFFICIENT SCORERS GUARDS IN THE CONFERENCE.

HIS CAREER IS HIGHLIGHTED BY EFFICIENT SHOOTING PERCENTAGES, DOUBLE-FIGURE SCORING PRODUCTION, CONFERENCE RECOGNITION, AND SEVERAL CLUTCH PERFORMANCES. HIS ABILITY TO CREATE HIS OWN OFFENSE, CONVERT PERIMETER SHOTS, AND MAKE PLAYS LATE IN GAMES PROVIDES A STRONG FOUNDATION FOR A PROFESSIONAL LEAD-GUARD PROFILE.

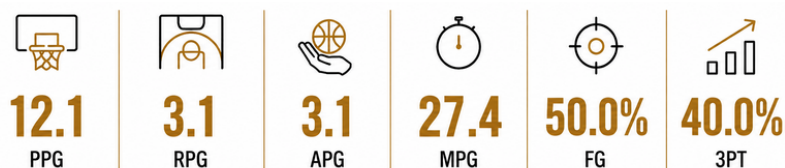

AIKEN BEGAN HIS COLLEGE CAREER AT WILEY UNIVERSITY AS A FRESHMAN POINT GUARD. HE APPEARED IN 17 GAMES, STARTING 14, AND AVERAGED APPROXIMATELY:

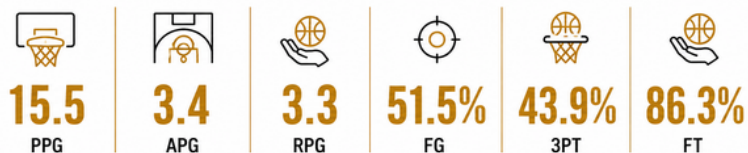

HE MADE 75 OF 150 FIELD-GOAL ATTEMPTS AND 16 OF 40 THREE-POINT ATTEMPTS. THOSE PERCENTAGES ARE PARTICULARLY NOTABLE FOR A FRESHMAN GUARD CARRYING MEANINGFUL OFFENSIVE RESPONSIBILITY.

AIKEN TRANSFERRED TO THE UNIVERSITY OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA AND QUICKLY DEVELOPED INTO ONE OF THE LEADING GUARDS IN THE EAST COAST CONFERENCE. HE APPEARED IN 25 GAMES AND AVERAGED:



HIS COMBINATION OF 51.5% FIELD-GOAL SHOOTING, 43.9% THREE-POINT SHOOTING AND 86.3% FREE-THROW SHOOTING PLACED HIM CLOSE TO THE HIGHLY REGARDED 50-40-85 EFFICIENCY BENCHMARK.

DURING THE SEASON, AIKEN WAS RANKED FOURTH IN THE CONFERENCE IN SCORING AT APPROXIMATELY 15.9 POINTS PER GAME AND SECOND IN THREE-POINT SHOOTING. HIS PERFORMANCE EARNED HIM SECOND-TEAM ALL-EAST COAST CONFERENCE HONORS

CLUTCH PERFORMANCE AGAINST LSU ALEXANDRIA

ON JANUARY 9, 2026, OUR LADY OF THE LAKE ERASED A 20-POINT DEFICIT AGAINST LSU ALEXANDRIA. WITH 2.3 SECONDS REMAINING, AIKEN CONVERTED A CONTESTED GO-AHEAD SHOT THAT GAVE OLLU ITS FIRST LEAD OF THE CLOSING SEQUENCE AND COMPLETED THE COMEBACK.

HE ALSO SCORED 11 POINTS WHILE SHOOTING 3-OF-5 FROM THREE AGAINST LSU SHREVEPORT AND RECORDED 13 POINTS IN AN EARLIER MATCHUP AGAINST WESTCLIFF.

AIKEN HAS CONSISTENTLY PRODUCED EFFICIENT SHOOTING PERCENTAGES. HE SHOT 50% FROM THE FIELD AND 40% FROM THREE AS A FRESHMAN AT WILEY, FOLLOWED BY 51.5% FROM THE FIELD AND 43.9% FROM THREE AT UDC. HIS OFFENSIVE STRENGTHS INCLUDE:

DEFENSE, REBOUNTING & IMPACT

ALTHOUGH UNDERSIZED RELATIVE TO SOME PROFESSIONAL GUARDS, AIKEN HAS PRODUCED EVIDENCE OF DEFENSIVE ACTIVITY. HIS FIVE-STEAL GAMES AT BOTH WILEY AND UDC SUGGEST STRONG ANTICIPATION, QUICK HANDS AND THE WILLINGNESS TO PRESSURE OPPOSING BALL-HANDLERS. HIS PROFESSIONAL DEFENSIVE VALUE WILL LIKELY DEPEND UPON:

AIKEN PROJECTS AS A QUICK, EFFICIENT LEAD GUARD WHO COULD PURSUE OPPORTUNITIES IN INTERNATIONAL BASKETBALL, DEVELOPMENTAL LEAGUES OR OTHER PROFESSIONAL COMPETITIONS. HIS STRONGEST PROFESSIONAL SELLING POINTS ARE HIS SHOOTING EFFICIENCY, EXPERIENCE, ABILITY TO CREATE OFFENSE AND DEMONSTRATED CONFIDENCE IN LATE-GAME SITUATIONS.

FOR A 5'10" GUARD, THE PATH TO PROFESSIONAL SUCCESS GENERALLY REQUIRES A CLEARLY DEFINED ELITE SKILL. AIKEN'S STRONGEST DIFFERENTIATORS ARE HIS OFFENSIVE EFFICIENCY, PERIMETER SHOOTING AND ABILITY TO CONTROL THE BALL. 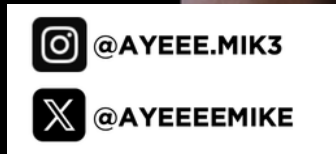
